

Housing Overview

(for parents, guardians, and families)

Process Overview:

1. Students who want to be part of the housing process must submit by March 22, 2024 at 5:00pm EST:

- a. the online housing application
- b. the \$450 housing deposit
- c. (if needed) the Specialized Housing request form
 - i. Please note: This must be resubmitted each year.

Students can also apply to a pilot Living Learning Community focused on sustainability (see below for details).

2. Students with Specialized Housing accommodations select their housing.

3. All other students participate in a lottery through the Generalized Housing process.

- a. **Rising sophomores** can participate as individuals or groups of 2–7 for rooms within apartments or full apartments in Hill House.
- b. **Rising juniors and seniors** participate as individuals or groups of 2–3.

The Generalized Housing process consists of two rounds. Students should view more details about the lottery on MySLC.

Important Dates:

- **March 22, 2024:** Deadline for the housing application, housing deposit, and Specialized Housing request form submissions
 - Rising juniors and seniors who submit their housing application and/or deposit late will be placed on the waitlist.
 - Rising sophomores who submit their housing application and/or deposit late will be moved to Final Selection.
- **May 15, 2024:** Deadline to request a refund for the housing deposit

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Ways to Support your Student through the Housing Process

Provide Emotional Support

Understand that choosing housing can be a big decision and may come with some stress or anxiety. Be a supportive listener and offer encouragement.

Stay Up To Date

Encourage Communication with Roommates or Housing Office

While you can offer guidance, let your student take the lead in the housing selection process. This is an opportunity for them to practice decision-making and problem-solving skills.

Respect Their Choices

Remember to balance support with allowing your student to take ownership of the decision-making process. This empowers them to develop important life skills and take responsibility for their own choices.
